The 2 - 5 Rule in regards to Annual Numbers

If you do no more that reduce the negative effects of the annual **2** or **5** in your home or business, Metal reduces Earth; you will have done yourself and your clients a great service.

The metal object should be soft or rounded in contour, and not sharp, jagged or harsh in contour. Don't introduce another sha. A metal bowl or wall mounted metal plate maybe sufficient when considering the annual 2 or 5 alone.

Annual Number Money enhancement

Put red earth in square containing annual number **6**, and metal in the square containing the annual number **1** for money enhancement.



How to float the Annual Numbers

There are 9 annual numbers, 1 - 9. Each year the number **decreases** by 1. After 1 it goes back to 9. 1998 was 2, 1999 was 1, 2000 is 9, 2001 is 8, etc.

1. Draw a nine-square grid. Put North at the bottom.
2. Enter the annual number in the center square.
3. Then fill in the outer squares in an **ascending** (1-9) order.

Float the numbers in this order. Let's use the annual number for the year 1999 (1) to better see where and how the numbers are floated.

- A. **Center** square, enter 1.
- B. **North West** square, enter 2.
- C. **West** square, enter 3.
- D. **North East** square, enter 4.
- E. **South** square, enter 5.
- F. **North** square, enter 6.
- G. **South West** square, enter 7.
- H. **East** square, enter 8.
- I. **South East** square, enter 9.

Your grid should like something like this:

You will then reduce the 2 and/or 5 (Metal reduces Earth) where they are found.
